PAUL GACEK is in his 25th year as Music Director of the Hamden Symphony Orchestra. As an undergraduate at Yale, he was founder, first president, and principal violist of the Yale Symphony Orchestra. He studied violin with Peter Salaff of the Cleveland Quartet and viola with David Schwartz, formerly of the NBC Symphony.

Mr. Gacek served as Music Director for theatrical productions with the Yale Dramatic Association, the New Haven Jewish Community Center, and the Southbury Playhouse. He toured Europe as Associate Music Director of the American Community Orchestra. He studied orchestral conducting with Gustav Meier and choral conducting with Fenno Heath.

PATRICIA MACABOY QUINTO began her musical training in 1974 under Lauren Loro, later studying under Kenneth Fears and Salvatore Amato. She has been principal flautist of the Hamden Symphony Orchestra since 1979. She has performed with the Earl Banquer Woodwind Ensemble, the Hamden Community Concert Band, the Connecticut Sinfonia Society, the Southern Connecticut Symphonic Pops Orchestra and Band, and the recently formed Wallingford Community Band. She currently is a part of the Living Word Ministries music ministry and performs with the Orion Trio and The Charter Oak Flutes.

Tricia is a resident of Wallingford with her husband and two daughters, and she runs a transcription business out of her home. She is dedicating this performance to her mother, Barbara Macaboy of Hamden, in appreciation for her musical encouragement and the gift of the piccolo she is playing today.
